SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

Concept

The Scholarship Programme is an **exclusive coaching program** dedicated to young drivers enrolled in the PCCI, aimed at competitive growth and improvement of sporting performance, which takes the form of the selection of a candidate to represent the Italian Championship at the International Shoot Out promoted by Porsche AG.

The selection criteria for the winner of the Italian program will not only be related to the sporting performance (i.e. ranking), but will evaluate the figure of the driver in round, with focus on physical and mental preparation, social media management skills, and knowledge of English.

The winner will have to represent the values of the Porsche brand.

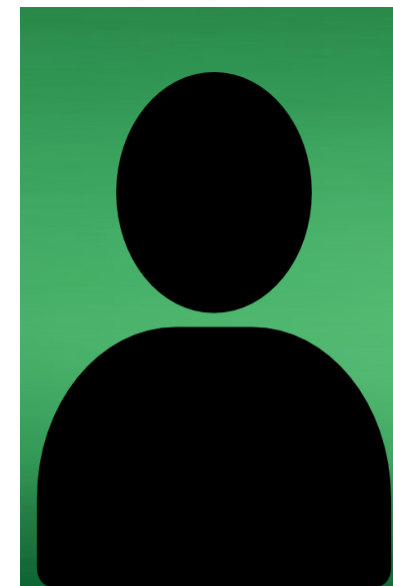
